

Year 5 - Autumn Term Curriculum Map

MATHS

In Maths, we are going to be completing the following units: Place Value; Addition and Subtraction; Multiplication and Division and Fractions. We will be encouraging the children to use mathematical thinking and build on their metacognitive skills. We will be focusing more on deeper thinking by ensuring children are using mathematical vocabulary when answering reasoning questions.

ENGLISH

In English, we are going to be reading one main text which is 'Harry Potter and The Philosophers Stone' and a range of Greek myths and legends. During our lessons, the children will write in a variety of styles such as, letters, diaries, debates, poems, narratives. During the week, the children will have 3 sessions dedicated to reading and developing skills of inference and comprehension.

SCIENCE

This term, pupils will be learning about:

- Living things and their Habitats
- Properties and changes of materials- irreversible and reversible changes, states of matter, conductivity, magnetism, transparency and solubility.

KEY TEXTS

- Harry Potter and The Philosophers Stone
- Greek myths and Legends

HISTORY

This term, year 5 will be learning all about Ancient Greece. We will learn when the Ancient Greeks lived and what life was like at the time and we will look at similarities and differences between ancient and modern Greece. Throughout the unit, we will study key events in Ancient Greece such as The Battle of Marathon and discover the roles of some important people such as Archimedes.

GEOGRAPHY

This term in Geography, we will be learning about the location of Greece in the world and learning new vocabulary such as 'Northern Hemisphere'. We will look at the climate of Greece and how this impacts daily life for modern Greek people. We will also be learning about the human and physical features of Greece and looking at modern Greek culture and lifestyles.

PE

During the Autumn term, Year 5 are going to be learning: Cricket, Football and Badminton. While doing Badminton they will learn the correct way to serve and return the shuttlecock as well as learn the rules and strategies of the game. During football lessons, we will be learning how to dribble, shoot, pass and defend whilst learning the rules and strategies of the game.

Spiritual, moral, social and cultural development (SMSC) PSHE/RE

- In PSHE, pupils will learn about puberty and how human bodies change as they grow.
- In RE, pupils will learn that Christians believe God is loving and holy. Pupils will compare Christian beliefs to humanist views.

MUSIC

In Music, we use the Charanga scheme of lessons in which pupils learn:

- To understand words, meaning and expression.
- To explore how Music shapes our way of life.
- To use body percussion, instruments and voices

ART/DT

- In Art, pupils will be creating a vase or bowl of Ancient Greek design.
- In DT, pupils will be developing skills of chopping and preparing food for a traditional Greek Salad.

COMPUTING

- **Computer Systems and Networks-** How information is transferred between systems and devices. They will explain the input, output, and process aspects of a variety of different real-world systems.
- **Creating Media** – How to use the tools of video editing software and create their own video.
