EYFS - Autumn Term Curriculum Map



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Communication and Language

We will be practising our listening and attentions skills during carpet sessions as well as learning to follow sets of instructions. Children will practise taking turns when speaking and responding appropriately.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

Our topic this term is, **Super Me! Super You!** We will learn about our physical features and discover what makes us the same but what also makes us unique! We will read 'The Colour Monster' to help us understand our different feelings and emotions.

Physical Development

In PE we will be exploring different ways of travelling around a space. Children will learn to find and negotiate safe spaces.

We will be working on our fine motor development by threading, using tweezers and practising using pens and pencils.

Literacy

We will introduce our Phonics scheme, Little Wandle and children will learn the sounds in Phase 2. Children will start applying their phonic skills in reading and will read as part of a group three times each week.

Maths

In Maths, we will be embedding a secure foundation of number and number sense by focusing on numbers 1-5, including composition and comparison of these numbers and matching and sorting quantities to numeral.

Understanding the World

As the term progresses, we will learn all about Autumn and notice the changes in our environment. We will also be learning about people who help us, in school, and in the local community. We will be celebrating Diwali, Bonfire Night and eventually, Christmas!

Expressive Arts and Design

Children will investigate colour and explore colour mixing. They will use a mirror to draw their own self portrait, looking closely at their own features. They will also make observational drawings of the world around them. They have daily access to role play and imaginative play as well as music.
